

A comment often heard from people trying to find St John's, the Church Hall or the Vicarage. Not exactly ideal for a church that is supposed to be there for everyone!

So in 2018 we removed a large tree from the garden in front of the church. However, the tree left behind it a rather unsightly brown patch. Fast forward a couple of years, and we were in lockdown and learning to do lots of things outdoors.

A church member suggested that the bare patch could be turned into a garden to be enjoyed and used by local people. With the help of a local garden expert, a team of volunteers and a generous grant from Stocksfield Parish Council the St John's 2020 Garden was born. It is meant to be a space where people can come and be, to find a moment of peace and perhaps remember; so please do come along and enjoy this lovely space.
